

## What is a "Christmas Miracle" Sponsor?

This Christmas Season, you can share the love by sponsoring a family in need through Operation Love Ministries! With over 250 registered families each year, 40-50 families with extreme circumstances are chosen for sponsorship (the remaining qualified applicants are guaranteed toys and a Christmas meal). OLM staff and volunteers work to prioritize all cases and only suggest sponsorship for those with the highest and most pressing needs.

To participate as a Christmas Miracle Sponsor, pledges of commitment should be made by November 15<sup>th</sup> at the latest. This gives OLM staff and volunteers time to communicate the sponsored family's information to sponsors (by Nov 18<sup>th</sup>), as well as providing several weeks for sponsors to shop before the December deadline for donations.

#### How Do I Give?

<u>Typically, sponsors commit to a \$100-500 donation OR commit provide at least the following:</u>

- 1) Food (or gift card) for a holiday meal for the family (see our enclosed suggested Christmas basket list), or a gift card to Payless grocery, Meijer, or Harvest Market (\$20- \$35 depending on family size).
- Gifts for each child under 18 (based on preferences listed on the application) \$50 per child, on average
- 3) Any "urgent needs" or extra items that the client may have listed on their application (such as hygiene or cleaning products, diapers, clothing/coats or even a Christmas tree (Anywhere from \$30-\$200)

Sponsors can expect to spend at least: \$100 for a family of 2, \$175 for a family of 3, \$250 for a family of 4, or \$350-\$500 for a family and/or a high-needs family.



Should you or your group choose to shop directly for these items, purchases are led by the discretion of our sponsors and vary from case to case. If you would like additional guidance or suggestions, please contact us.

## Your Sponsored Family Match

If you have any specific requests for your budget, what size family you would like, ages, or specific types of cases, our Human Services Coordinator will make the best effort to match you to a family that meets your interests. After you have committed to a case for sponsorship, we will scan and e-mail or make a hard copy of the application information from your chosen family, including their sizes, "Christmas wishes," for each child, and their application narrative explaining why they requested assistance this year. You may pick up the hard copy of this application at the OLM offices, or we may deliver to you if we are able.

## **Delivering Christmas Wishes**

Sponsors may choose how involved they would like to be with their sponsored family. They can choose to deliver the items as follows:

- 1) Sponsors may contact the family directly by December 3<sup>rd</sup> to ask any questions about gift details and arrange a delivery or off-site pickup anytime before Dec. 23<sup>rd</sup>,
- 2) Sponsors may bring the completed baskets to Operation Love the week of December 6th so that OLM can arrange pickup from the client, or
- 3) Sponsors may choose a day and time (Dec 13<sup>th</sup>-16<sup>th</sup>) to meet at Operation Love to give the items to the sponsored family.

# **Christmas Sponsorship Schedule:**

- **Nov. 15**<sup>th</sup>: Deadline to commit to sponsor a Christmas Wishes family. Email Andrea Baker at <a href="mailto:abaker@operationloveministries.org">abaker@operationloveministries.org</a> or call 765-644-2121
- Nov. 22<sup>nd</sup>: All committed sponsors will receive information about their sponsored family by this date.
- Dec 6<sup>th</sup>: All donations that are not being given directly to a family must be dropped off at Operation Love Ministries, or a time must be coordinated to meet with a sponsored family at Operation Love between Dec. 6<sup>th</sup>-9<sup>th</sup> or Dec 13<sup>th</sup>-16<sup>th</sup>. (OLM is closed the last 2 weeks of Dec.)
- Dec 23<sup>rd</sup>: All donations made directly to a sponsored family should be delivered. You will have the family's address and contact information should you choose to arrange delivery.
