

2025 ANNUAL REPORT: OLM BY THE NUMBERS



25,747 INDIVIDUALS FED ↑2,235

8,151 food orders were issued with OLM's weekly food pantry and monthly bonus pantry with 25,747 individuals fed. Families are able to use each pantry once a month.

399 FAMILIES SERVED

Many families need help with clothing and home goods, especially as their children grow, or if they are starting overdue to shelter insecurity, a domestic situation, or other emergency. Families choose 20 clothing items for each documented family member and a selection of home goods.



517 BABIES DIAPERED

Families can receive a box of diapers each month for each documented child during their Food Pantry visit.




8,439 VOLUNTEER HOURS ↑10%

\$30,888.22 IN FINANCIAL ASSISTANCE

The OLM Balanced Budget Program gives tools for success while also making direct-vendor payments for documented emergencies for program graduates. Over 244 families (a 155% increase) received budget coaching & completed 570 goals through these programs in 2025 (increase of 224%).



493 SCHOOL CHILDREN SERVED

493 children received backpacks and 80-95% of school supplies from their specific school's list through OLM's Back to School Readiness Program.



305 FAMILIES: CHRISTMAS MEAL

305 families received a Christmas Food Basket with all the items needed to make a traditional Christmas dinner during OLM's Christmas Wishes Program.



757 KIDS: CHRISTMAS GIFTS

OLM's Christmas Wishes program provided gifts, stocking stuffers, winter-wear items, clothes, coats, shoes, and books for 757 children. Families also received hygiene and cleaning items with their food box.
